Review 2017/18

Spending focussed on:

1: Attainment

To raise attainment for, and diminish the difference between, disadvantaged pupils and non-disadvantaged children across the curriculum.

2: Engagement and Aspiration

To improve curriculum engagement and aspiration for disadvantaged pupils.

3: Early Years

To improve the outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in Early Years especially through the development of early language and speaking and listening skills.

Outcomes:

- 1. In the Year 1 phonics test there were three pupils, 66% of whom were Pupil Premium. PP attained in line with non
- 2. In the Year 2 SAT tests there were four pupils. 50% of pupil premium pupils attained the expected standard.
- 3. In the Year 6 SAT tests, PP performed well.

There was an increase in the percentage of pupils attaining greater depth.
